

Curriculum

As a school, we will:

ensure that every child is taught at an appropriate and challenging level;

maintain an attractive environment with good materials and equipment and teach the full National Curriculum.

As a Parent/ Carer I will:

encourage my child to participate fully in school activities;

support my child's learning at school by attending parents' meetings and performances;

provide my child with suitable clothing for school activities.

Homework

As a school, we will:

set appropriate homework regularly and ensure that it is marked.

As a Parent/ Carer I will:

help my child to return homework on time;

help my child find a quiet place and time to do homework;

ensure that school property is looked after when at home;

read to and with my child frequently.

Behaviour

As a school, we will:

make sure that children are familiar with school rules;

use rewards and sanctions fairly;

make sure the school staff always set a high standard of behaviour;

respect the views of children and parents, acknowledging that different views may be held.

As a Parent/ Carer I will:

help my child to understand and follow school rules;

encourage my child to care for school property both at home and at school;

behave in a way that sets a good example for children when I am on the school premises.

Attendance and Punctuality

As a school, we will:

start school promptly at 8.55am;

maintain an accurate record of attendance;

monitor attendance and punctuality closely and meet with parents and/or refer to the Education Welfare Officer when a child's attendance or punctuality become a concern.

As a Parent/ Carer I will:

make sure that my child is at school regularly and arrives on time;

make sure that my child is picked up at the end of the school day on time;

contact the school promptly when my child is absent for any reason.

Equal Opportunities

As a school, we will:

try to enable all children to take part in activities;

celebrate the diverse backgrounds we come from;

use different cultural examples in teaching;

ensure that bullying and racist, sexist and other discriminating behaviour is not tolerated.

As a Parent/ Carer I will:

help my child to understand that everyone is of importance;

encourage my child to appreciate and respect the views and religions of others.

Welfare and Communication

As a school, we will:

ensure that children are safe on the school premises and on school trips;

administer medicines only with permission;

give full and clear information about the curriculum and about each child's progress and development needs;

communicate frequently with parents about school matters.

As a Parent/ Carer I will:

teach my child about personal hygiene;

make sure that the school always has my up to date contact number;

raise any concerns with the appropriate person as soon as possible;

let the school know of any issues that may affect my child's welfare or progress at school.


