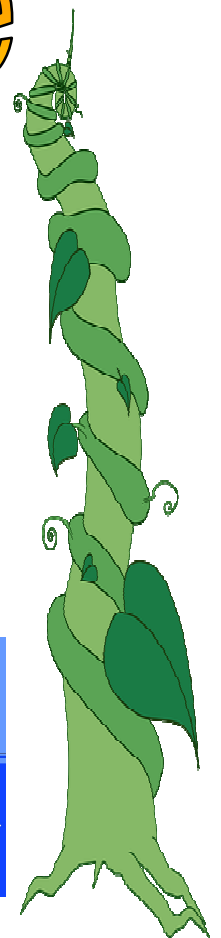
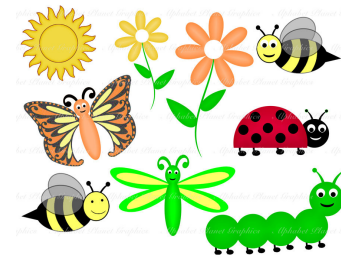

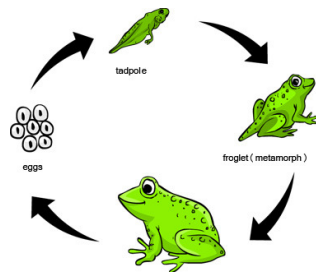
Lets Explore



This term we are learning about...

Environments; Kempston, Farm, Jungle, Arctic, African grasslands.

Life-cycles; tadpole to frog, egg to chicken, caterpillar to butterfly.



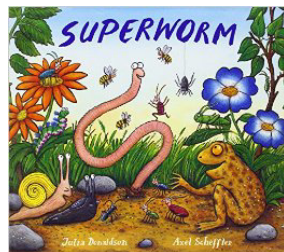
Spring; what changes happen from winter to spring e.g. baby animals born, plants start to grow, birds fly back from their migration.

Plant Growth; what plants need to grow.

Our bodies; how we grow from baby to adult.

How to Keep Healthy; exercise, healthy foods, washing hands & keeping clean, getting enough sleep.

Superworm / Superheroes; how do you become a superhero? what superpowers do you have? what is your superhero name?



You might like to join in with our learning at home by:

- ★ Walking around Kempston; talk about what you see as you walk past, also notice numbers and signs.
- ★ Have a walk along the river; collect items along the walk, listen to the sounds, talk about what you can see.
- ★ Visit Kempston library & look at non-fiction books to find out about life-cycles, spring and how to stay healthy.
- ★ Go on a pattern hunt around your home & garden & make rubbings of bark, bricks, paths etc.
- ★ Choose fun activities to do as a family to promote the importance of exercise.
- ★ Make healthy foods together e.g. fruit kebabs, flapjacks.
- ★ Practice independence skills; doing up coat, dressing and undressing without help.
- ★ Read lots of books to your child and let them have a go at looking at the pictures and telling you a story.
